

Podcast Transcript: Introduction to New CALiOTM

The National Children's Advocacy Center is pleased to announce the launch of the New and Improved Child Abuse Library Online-CALiOTM. New CALiOTM is easier to navigate and search, meaning that you find what you need in less time.

New features include CALiO™Collections, a keyword searchable database of all the library's open full text collections. Collections such as Poly-victimization, Statistical Resources, Community Resources, and Bibliographies may still be searched separately as well.

CALiO's restricted access section has expanded to include CALiOTMSuperSearch, which includes search of three EBSCO databases, 1,500 journals, numerous newspapers, conference proceedings, books, and all of CALiO's collections in one interface. The restricted access section also provides access to Andrew Agatston's Legal Letters, The Foundation Directory Online, and full text collections of research especially prepared to meet the needs of child maltreatment professionals.

As always, a full time librarian is available when you still need assistance with article retrieval, topical search, or many other research related questions.
